This free, day-long training session will provide an understanding of the various FEMA mapping products available and how these products can be used. Participants will learn about:

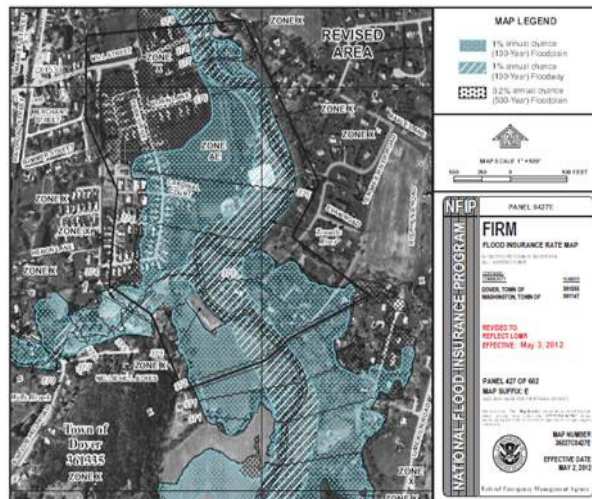
- Flood risk, especially as it pertains to the Eastern and Western Catskills;
- The National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP);
- FEMA's Flood Insurance Study (FIS) reports and Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs), and how to use these products; and
- FEMA's Letters of Map Change (e.g., LOMAs, LOMRs).

Community, county, and regional officials are encouraged to attend, as are all stakeholders interested in using Digital Flood Insurance Rate Maps (DFIRMs) and Risk MAP products in the West of Hudson watersheds. Please share this invitation with the appropriate individuals.

Continuing Education credits for participation in this training will be available for New York State Engineers and Land Surveyors (6 hours), and for Certified Floodplain Managers (6 credits).

Breakfast and lunch will be provided for training participants.

A second training geared toward more advanced use of FEMA mapping products (for those with a GIS background) will be offered in April; look out for more information about this in the coming weeks.
